

## MINUTES OF PLAN MTG JUNE 3

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Chairman Dennis Kroll. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Notices were posted and sent to members. Approve the agenda with move of Item 10 to Item 9 by Reinhard, Scd Bagnnet, Passed 5-0. Motion to approve the minutes of the May meeting by VanLannen, Scd Reinhard, Passed 5-0.

Russell Peters brought a petition to rezone 5.99 acres from Ag to Rural Residential. He will make a separate driveway to access the new parcel. Motion to recommend approval of the rezone to the county by VanLannen, Scd Kroll, Passed 5-0,

Larry Smith had a petition to rezone 5 acres from Ag to Rural Residential to separate the house and farm buildings from the rest of the agriculture land. Motion to approve the petition by Reinhard, Scd Bagnnet, Passed 5-0.

A petition from Larry Smith for Larry Jarosinski to rezone property in Section 30 will be tabled to the July meeting, Motion to table by VanLannen, Scd Bagnnet passed 5-0.

Shirley Splan wants to sell her mother's property on N Brown County Road. The neighbor installed a septic system on part of her property seventeen years ago. The permit for the septic system was signed by the Oconto County Zoning office and was installed by Murphy company. She will take the problem up with county zoning; the town has no authority to act on this.

Richard Lodl discussed an easement to his property; he will make it a driveway to connect to Lower Road instead of the easement.

Reinhard presented bills for the prizes bought for the town picnic. Motion to approve all the bills for payment to the town board by Bagnnet, Scd VanLannen, Passed 5-0.

The Park Commission approved holding \$50.00 of the deposit from the last Barn rental because the tent was not removed for three days and the key was not returned promptly. It was Memorial weekend. After discussion a motion to recommend to the town board to retain \$150.00 of the deposit by Bagnnet, Scd Reinhard passed 5-0.

Motion to adjourn to July 8, 2015 by Reinhard, Scd Bagnnet, Passed 5-0.
