

PROCEEDINGS – September 07, 2016
TOWN OF CHASE PLAN COMMISSION MEETING

1. Call to Order and Roll Call

Plan Commission Chairman, Dennis Kroll called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. in the Chase Town Hall, located at 8481 County Road S, Pulaski WI 54162. Notices were posted in the three town display boxes which are located at the Town Recycling Center, North Chase Citgo, and South Chase Saloon. Plan Commission Members present: Chairman – Dennis Kroll, Gary Van Lannen, Norb Reinhard Jr., Perry Baugnet, Secretary/Clerk - Tammy Willems

2. Recite the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag

3. Approve the Agenda

Motion by Van Lannen/Baugnet to approve agenda. The motion was called and carried 5-0.

4. Hear and Approve Prior Meeting Minutes

Motion by Van Lannen/Reinhard to approve the previous meeting minutes. The motion was called and carried 5-0.

5. Discuss and Act on Recycling Program Options

Due to municipal interest, County has a new proposal to continue running the current recycling program with the townships contributing toward the costs of running it.

Motion by Reinhard/Baugnet to recommend to the Town Board to stay with the Oconto County recycling program. The motion was called and carried 5-0.

6. Discuss and Act on Park Commission Issues

Norb Reinhard presented the bill for the floor painting for payment. Motion by Baugnet/Reinhard to recommend passing the park bill on to the Town Board for approval. The motion was called and carried 4-0, Van Lannen abstained.

It was suggested at the Park Commission Meeting that the Stone Barn 3 day rental package fees would be reduced to \$3500.00 and other fees would remain. Plan Commission discussion was held on additionally lowering the 1 day package by an additional \$500.

Motion by Reinhard/Baugnet to recommend to the Town Board to reduce the Stone Barn Contract 3 day rental fee to \$3500.00 and the 1 day rental fee to \$3000.00 effective immediately. The motion was called and carried 5-0.

Two upcoming events at the Stone Barn Park will be the Scenic Road Rally and Pumpkin Sale from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and a drive through booyah on Sunday, November 6. Two contracts were presented for parking lot lights at the Stone Barn Park.
