

**PROCEEDINGS – October 07, 2016
TOWN OF CHASE PLAN COMMISSION MEETING**

1. Call to Order and Roll Call

Plan Commission Chairman, Dennis Kroll called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. in the Chase Town Hall, located at 8481 County Road S, Pulaski WI 54162. Notices were posted in the three town display boxes which are located at the Town Recycling Center, North Chase Citgo, and South Chase Saloon. 2. Recite the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag

3. Approve the Agenda

Motion by Baugnet/Reinhard to change the sequence of the agenda to move #6 after #4. The motion was called and carried 5-0.

4. Hear and Approve Prior Meeting Minutes

Motion by Van Lannen/Reinhard to approve the previous meeting minutes. The motion was called and carried 5-0.

5. Discuss and Act on Recycling Program Options

County proposed a new 3 year contract with the townships funding the full costs of it. Dennis Kroll investigated the requirements of becoming a responsible unit and the contractor and hauler costs to be on our own. Several contractors were present and answered questions and presented proposals for review.

Motion by Reinhard/Baugnet to recommend to the Town Board not to stay with the Oconto County recycling program and have the Town become our own responsible unit. The motion was called and carried 5-0.

Motion by Van Lannen/Reinhard to recommend to the Town Board the Advance Disposal proposal for approval. The motion was called and carried 5-0.

6. Discuss and Act on Park Commission Issues

Road rally was held at the Stone Barn Park, the turnout was lower than expected due to the weather conditions. There will be vegetable cutting the night before for the booyah on Sunday Nov. 6th at the Barn.

Motion by Baugnet/Reinhard to recommend passing the park bills on to the Town Board for approval. Bills were for booyah vegetables and booyah signs.

7. Discuss and Act Reducing Lower Road & Mapleridge Circle to 45mph

Discussion was held on reducing the speed on Lower Road to match the Town of Little Suamico section so the entire length is 45 mph. Also, discussion was held to include the Mapleridge Circle subdivision.
