

PROCEEDINGS – March 14, 2022
TOWN OF CHASE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING

1. Call to Order and Roll Call

Town Board Chairman, Gary Van Lannen called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. in the Chase Town Hall, located at 8481 County Road S, Pulaski WI 54162. Notices were posted in the three town display boxes, which are located at the Town Recycling Center, North Chase Citgo, and South Chase Saloon. 4. Approve Prior Meeting Minutes

Motion by Kroll/Van Enkevort to approve 10 percent of booth fees per sale as compensation for organizing the craft sales. Motion was called and carried 3-0.

a. Election Employee Trainings

Van Lannen stated on the Employee Fee Schedule the Board wants to clarify that the in town training is exempt for the election poll workers. The election poll workers are paid their hourly wage for training.

Motion by Kroll/Van Enkevort to approve the exemption for election poll workers from in town training. Election poll workers will be paid their hourly wage for in town training. Motion was called and carried 3-0.

11. Discuss and Act on Joint Marketing Contribution with Oconto County Economic Development

Van Lannen stated the town would like to contribute \$500.00 for joint marketing with Oconto County Economic Development.

Motion by Kroll/Van Lannen to approve the contribution of \$500.00 for joint marketing with Oconto County Economic Development. Motion was called and carried 3-0.
