

**PROCEEDINGS – April 11, 2022**  
**TOWN OF CHASE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING**

**1. Call to Order and Roll Call**

Town Board Chairman, Gary Van Lannen called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. in the Chase Town Hall, located at 8481 County Road S, Pulaski WI 54162. Notices were posted in the three town display boxes, which are located at the Town Recycling Center, North Chase Citgo, and South Chase Saloon. Van Lannen stated this has been an ongoing situation with the Plan Commission. Nelson said it is not feasible to put the road in. Nelson also stated he is going to move and wants to put all lots into a new CSM with one lot and then sell. He is then asking the Town Board to discontinue the road. Kroll will call Oconto County Zoning to further find out the recommendations for the problem from the County.

Motion by Kroll/Van Enkevort to table for the sending of the letter from the lawyer regarding Mulberry Lane for one month. Motion was called and carried 3-0.
